

# 2010 EAST COAST TOUR

## ITINERARY: JULY 3 - 18, 2010

### **DAY 1: Saturday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>**

Early morning departure from Timmins at 7 a.m., with other pick-ups to be arranged. Coffee and lunch stops to be arranged. We will overnight in Toronto.

### **DAY 2 & 3: Sunday, July 4<sup>th</sup> & Monday July 5<sup>th</sup>**

You will be joined on Sunday morning by your escort from Pathway Tours and other tour participants. We take the shortest route to the Canadian maritime provinces, crossing New York State, Vermont & New Hampshire. We will spend one night near Rutland, VT and one night in Bangor, ME.

### **DAY 4: Tuesday, July 6<sup>th</sup>**

After breakfast we will be re-entering Canada, with a stop in beautiful St. Andrews before arriving in St. John, NB. We include a visit to the Reversing Falls and the Hall of Great Whales. There will also be time to visit the Market Square shopping centre in St. John.

### **DAY 5: Wednesday, July 7<sup>th</sup>**

Today it's not far to Fundy National Park. We will visit the Ocean Tidal Exploration Sites and take in the magnificent views of the Bay of Fundy. Our next stop is Moncton and a visit to Magnetic Hill. There will also be time to shop at the enormous Champlain Place shopping centre. Before the day is done we will be crossing the Confederation Bridge on our way to Charlottetown, PE where we will spend two nights.

### **DAY 6: Thursday, July 8<sup>th</sup>**

While in Charlottetown we plan to visit Founders Hall & Green Gables House. We have reserved tickets for the musical Anne of Green Gables and we will also include a delicious lobster dinner one of the nights!

### **DAY 7: Wednesday, July 9<sup>th</sup>**

In the morning we will take the ferry across Northumberland Strait to Pictou, NS. From here we travel to Cape Breton Island, with several interesting stops including Rita McNeils' Tea House.

### **DAY 8: Thursday, July 10<sup>th</sup>**

Our journey takes us to North Sydney, with some spectacular scenery on the way and time for some leisurely photo stops.

**DAY 9 - 12: Friday, July 11<sup>th</sup> to Monday, July 14<sup>th</sup>**

After breakfast we leave Cape Breton Island, and expect to arrive in Halifax, NS in the late afternoon. There is so much to see and do in and around Halifax, and we trust you will enjoy your stay here for four nights! While in Halifax we will include visits to Pier 21, the Historic Waterfront Properties, and the public gardens. One of the days we will offer an excursion along the Lighthouse Route to Lunenburg, Peggy's Cove & Mahone Bay. You will also have one day 'at leisure' for you to explore or relax as you wish.

**DAY 13: Tuesday, July 15<sup>th</sup>**

After leaving Halifax in the morning we travel to Annapolis Royal, the oldest European settlement in Canada. We will have a lunch stop in Digby and a chance to sample their famous scallops. Later in the day we reach Yarmouth where we board the CAT, to cross the Bay of Fundy and arriving in Portland, ME.

**DAY 14: Wednesday, July 16<sup>th</sup>**

After breakfast we have time for some sightseeing before continuing our homeward journey which will take us to Utica, NY.

**DAY 15: Thursday, July 17<sup>th</sup>**

We expect to arrive back in Canada by mid-afternoon with a stop at the duty free shop before leaving the US. Our overnight stop will be in Toronto, ON.

**DAY 16: Friday, July 18<sup>th</sup>**

There will be time to think about your tour highlights before you say farewell to your fellow travellers from northern Ontario. Coffee and lunch stops will be arranged by your tour escort. There will be many memories to treasure and to share when you arrive back home.
